

## CONTACT LENS POLICY

No two eyes are alike. When we prescribe contact lenses for you, we must custom fit them to your eyes. Though many of the measurements necessary to fit contact lenses are taken during your routine exam, additional calculations must be made to adjust your prescription to the contact lens format. Due to the complexity of accurately fitting contact lenses, considerable professional judgment and experience are required.

**If you have questions or concerns about our policy of the charges, please feel free to review it with a member of our staff before your visit today.**

**Please carefully read the following descriptions of our different levels of contact lens fittings and initial the statements below.**

- Level 1 – Annual contact lens check usually performed at annual eye exam, no follow up visits required...\$40.00
- Level 2 – Annual contact lens check usually performed at annual eye exam with first time fitting in our office or change in contact lens type requiring 1-3 follow up visits...\$70.00
- Level 3 – Annual contact lens check usually performed at annual eye exam for first time wearers or significant change in lens type requiring a class and 1-3 follow up visits...\$100.00
- Level 4 – Annual contact lens check usually performed at annual eye exam for hard to fit contact lenses such as kerataconus or bifocal lens wearers requiring several follow up visits...\$200.00

\_\_\_\_\_ I have read the above statements and understand the policy described.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that contact lens and evaluation fees are ***not usually covered by my insurance***. Most insurance plans are exclusive of any contact lens care. Payment for contact lens evaluations and fittings are due at the time of my visit.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that one of the most important parts of fitting contact lenses is my commitment to schedule and participate in follow-up visits. These exams are necessary to insure that my lenses are the best for my vision and eye health.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that in Dr. Drucker's office, contact lenses are considered medical devices and prescriptions may be released at the doctor's discretion only when a proper fit is determined through the contact lens fitting and follow-up procedures.

### Refund Policy

\_\_\_\_\_ Refunds or credit may be given on ***unopened, undamaged*** boxes of lenses within 30 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ Specialty contacts (gas permeable lenses, custom toric lenses, etc.) are customized for you and will only receive a partial refund (depending upon each individual manufacturer guidelines) and must be returned within 30 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ Refunds apply to materials only and not to professional services.
